geleget und ineinander verschlungen.

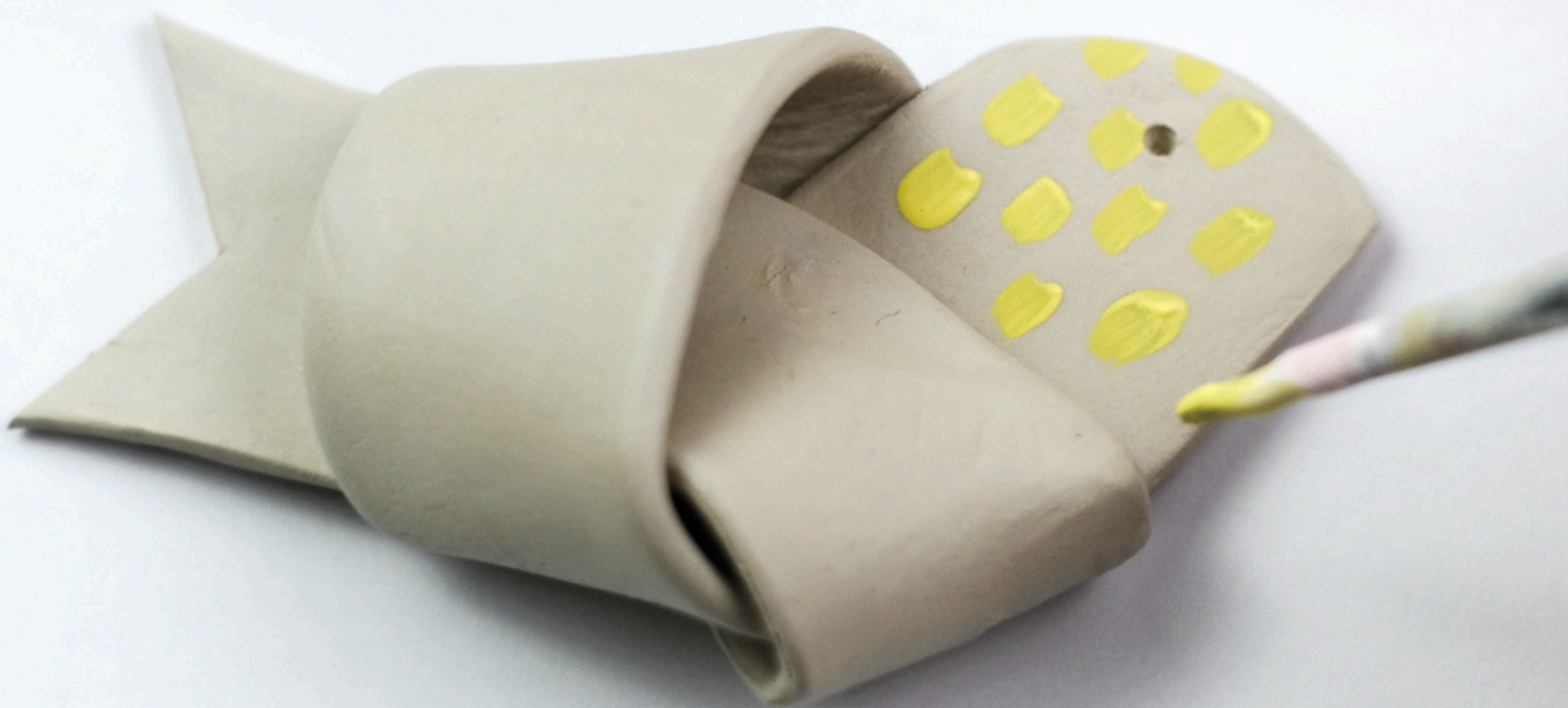
